







BEFORE YOU LEAVE HOME

To help you prepare for your boating holiday we'll send you a range of useful information including:

- The map of how to get to the base, public transport details and contact details in case you need to speak to our local team before your arrival.
- Boat inventory: list of equipment fitted to the boat (inside and outside).
- The waterways guide that you will receive by post if you have ordered it: this guide is essential for the smooth running of your boating holiday. You will find locks, water points, pontoons, tourist attractions, etc. Remember to order it before you leave!
- Instruction documents both for the on board facilities and equipment but also the mechanical operation of your boat.
- Navigation advice and safety instructions: all presented and animated via fun and educational videos.



YOUR LUGGAGE

Holdalls are recommended - they are easy to stow away. Suitcases do take up far more space on board, so perhaps unpack them and leave in the boot of your car. Take with you comfortable non slip shoes so that you can move on the deck without danger (tennis or baskets).

Don't forget sun glasses and sun creams, hats, gloves... and your camera!





WATERWAYS GUIDES

A comprehensive guide is vital for planning your cruise. It provi-ALSAR des detailed information of the waterways on which you will navigate highlighting useful information such as the location of locks, quays, water fill-up points in addition to tourist information such as places to visit and their opening hours, market days, good restaurants and much more. We recommend you order your waterways guide at the same time as booking so that you receive it with the other cruise documentation you will be sent. This means you will have plenty of time to plan your journey in advance.



ON ARRIVAL AT THE BASE

Free public parking is available at all of our bases. Alternatively, at a supplementary cost, you can park your vehicle in a secure area or garage. Generally these facilities are unattended. A few formalities will need to be attended to whilst other members of the group load your luggage or perhaps go off to do some basic shopping to get you through your first day. One of our technicians will come aboard with you to show you how to operate your boat. Whenever possible he will be with you when you negotiate your first lock. You'll soon see that navigation is child's play. Now it's time to cast off!



AT THE END OF YOUR CRUISE

Remember to return the boat on time!

- 4-5 PM for a weekend cruise,
- 8-9 AM for longer cruises.

The personnel at the base can supply you with necessary materials to give the boat a good clean.



NAVIGATION IS EASY!

Our boats are easy to operate with either just one inside steering position or a second rooftop position to navigate under the sun with a panoramic view.

You will discover **simple controls that are easy to use:** the wheel, a gear lever and a few instruments on the dashboard. Don't worry if you've never been on a boat before - we'll show you everything you need to know before you set off. You'll be taken out on the water and given a hands on demonstration of everything from how to go through locks to tying up at the water's edge.

WARNING: the minimum age to take the helm of a boat is 16 years old but they must remain under the captain's (an adult!) responsibility.



CANAL OR RIVER?


Most of the waterways in our brochure are generally wide and nontidal making them easy to navigate. Depending on your chosen departure base you may cruise on both canals and rivers.

Rivers, where natural, are more susceptible to the possibility of flooding compared to the manmade canals - especially in Spring and Autumn.

Some navigation restrictions may occur as a result of this flooding and for your own safety we may change your departure base or restrict cruising to the canal sections only, rather than cancelling your cruise completely. Please make enquiries about the state of the waterways before leaving on your cruise.



LOCKS



- Will I have to pay? Passage through locks and bridges is free.
- Are they automatic? Most locks are automatic and operated by a lock keeper who may ask you to help them, whilst others are manual. In the Charente and the Lot the locks are all operated by you and your crew, thus you are not restricted by timetables.
- Are there days of closing? Most locks are automatic and operated by a lock keeper who will be happy to help you.
 In general, lock keepers do not work on Bank Holidays: Example in France: 1st May and 1st November. For a list of regions concerned please contact us.



WHERE TO STOP

During your cruise **you're free to stop wherever you like...**being careful not to disrupt the countryside and wildlife (or encroach on private property!) simply moor up and step ashore.

Day-by-day you'll discover new surroundings and sights as you travel at your own pace through beautiful countryside - a wonderful way to enjoy ever-changing scenery and the great outdoors.

If on the other hand you prefer the hustle and bustle of the towns and villages you pass on route then take advantage of the purposebuilt ports and mooring sites. Some are free while others are available at a small charge (this varies depending on the size of the boat and whether there are power charging points). We estimate charges to be between 10€ to 50€. These comfortable and serviced areas will provide easy access to the town.

BICYCLES

Bikes are available to hire from all of our bases and provide extra flexibility for exploring the area where you've moored, little villages, places of interest or simply for going to buy your daily bread.

A helmet is mandatory for children under 12 years of age: please remember to bring your equipment.



FISHING

Your boat is a great vantage point for fishing from. You can fish in the canals and rivers providing you hold a fishing licence. These can be purchased from local fishing tackle shops or on the web (www.cartedepeche.fr). As a guide, a 7-day licence for fishing will cost around 34 € in France and 40 € in Germany. In Portugal it's a one off cost of 25 € regardless of the length of your holiday.



BARBECUE

Hire all of the equipment you'll need to a enjoy a barbecue, then simply pick up your food fresh from the many mooring places you'll find on route. Take it on board with you...most of our bases even offer rental of gas bottles. As with all barbecues please be careful and familiarise yourself with all the equipment before departure.



WiFi

Whether it's your tablet, laptop or mobile phone... stay connected during your cruise! Most of our bases offer a Wifi service that will allow you to connect multiple devices simultaneously*. For more information please contact us.

N.B.: for boats of 13 m length and more a pleasure boat licence is necessary due to the total length of the boat plus pool.

Pets are welcome onboard. A supplement of 50 € will be requested when you depart the base. Don't forget to bring their belongings (feeding bowl, bedding/blankets etc) and when travelling ensure that they remain safe and cannot cause any harm or damage.

LET'S TAKE CARE OF THE ENVIRONMENT TOGETHER!





By hiring a canal boat you are choosing a holiday set at the heart of nature so we know that wildlife and the countryside is important to you. The quality of the environment in which you will be navigating in contributes greatly to the enjoyment of your holiday, so between us let's protect it together. Our small actions... can have big effects!

How Nicols is helping the environment:



Nicols is committed to the preservation of the Canal du Midi: as a patron, we are participating in the replanting of trees along the Canal du Midi.



In 2018, Nicols created the first fully electric powered canal boat in Europe. For 2022, Nicols is continuing to add 'green' boats to the fleet with a second electric powered boat (details on page 48).



In Portugal, the entire Nicols fleet is equipped with solar panels.



Since 2019 Nicols has been part of APER, an ecoorganisation in France created by the Federation of Nautical Industries, who promote eco-responsible activity on the waterways.

How you can help us protect nature:



When mooring, be careful not to damage the plant species around you.



Leave no trace of your visit: pick up your rubbish and dispose of it at the designated waste disposal services found on route. Also, try and think about sorting your waste – what might be able to be recycled?



Navigate gently and carefully so as not to damage or erode the river banks.



When collecting your boat Nicols will offer you a welcome kit including biodegradable cleaning products. If however you bring your own cleaning and hygiene products, you too should choose biodegradable products.



Water is a precious resource, but one which is needed for many different things: drinking water, fauna and flora, agriculture, fishing, boating holidays... During your boating holiday you will pass through locks. At lock operation a minimum of 800m3 of water is used and goes downstream of the waterway. To help save water we must limit situations where single boats pass through alone as much as possible. Remember to group with other boats when passing through locks.



MALESTROIT

BRITTANY



At the crossroads of l'Erdre, la Vilaine and the Nantes to Brest Canal, discover the charms of Inland Brittany: waterways devoted entirely to pleasure cruising, its traditions, its seafood, delicious crepes and traditional cider!

FROM GLÉNAC AND SUCÉ-SUR-ERDRE



Explore a land of magic and mystery, rich in colour and traditions with a boating holiday in Brittany cruising the canal from Nantes to Brest. Enjoy historical treasures and remarkable natural sites: Josselin, with its magnificent castle reflected in the water; Malestroit and its 15th century houses; the craftsman village of Gacilly; Redon founded in 832 or Blain (traditional popular arts museum)...

The river Vilaine takes you to Rennes, the capital of Brittany, and on to Dinan and the surrounded ramparts dating back to the 13th century. Following the Erdre you'll pass fantastic golf courses. Count 17 castles within just 15km of waterways on this stretch! In two hours of locks free cruising you'll be at the heart of the city of Nantes and all its treasures: Cathedral St Pierre, Chateau des Ducs de Bretagne, Pommeraye passage, Museum of Fine Arts, the Machines of the Isle... to name just a few!

GREZ-NEUVILLE

ANJOU



The beautiful and welcoming valleys of Anjou are just 2 hours and 30 minutes from Paris. A cruise on the Sarthe and Mayenne rivers takes you to the heart of the region's rich heritage with numerous castles, mills and character villages to explore.

A boating holiday in this area a great option for those new to the waterways.

FROM **GREZ-NEUVILLE**

Dotted along the banks of the Mayenne river are numerous places to visit such as the Lion d'Angers equestrian centre, the millennial city of Château-Gontier, the Port-Salut abbey at Entrammes and the historical cities of Laval and King René's Angers. Cycling enthusiasts will appreciate the excellent 'EuroVelo' towpath that runs along the river, specifically geared to cyclists and an award winner in 2017. Another hidden gem is the small and calm Oudon river that flows into the Mayenne close to Grez-Neuville and is therefore a must see.



FROM **SABLÉ-SUR-SARTHE**

Discover the pretty Sarthe river and the surrounding delights. Meandering through verdant countryside dotted with picturesque villages. There are very few locks along its reaches, so it's ideal for beginners. Don't miss **the most elegant castle of Plessis Bourré**, the imposing Benedictine Abbey of Solesmes, Malicorne, capital of artistic porcelain and the older part of Le Mans town... Also enjoy local specialities such as rillettes du Mans!







FROM **LE SOMAIL**


From the charming small port of Le Somail, cruise away to discover the Canal du Midi in the direction of Carcassonne or if your cruising time permits down to Narbonne close to the Mediterranean Sea. You will cruise on the largest canal section in France without any locks (52 km) up to the Fonseranes staircase, situated close to the historical city of Béziers.

A few kilometres more and you arrive, via Agde, to the huge Etang de Thau - renowned for its oyster beds...

FROM **PORT-LAURAGAIS**

Cast off from our base in Port-Lauragais and sail west towards **Toulouse**, **named the "pink city"** because of its red brick buildings, rich with points of interest for tourists - Heritage Capitol museum, city of Space to name a couple.


IRELAND



Beautiful nature sourrounds the Shannon River which at 220km is the longest river in the British Isles. It is also a paradise for fishermen and is perfect for those new to boating holidays as there is no commercial traffic on the waterways and only a few locks to negotiate. Picturesque little villages dotted along the waterways invite you to slow down and explore this wonderful region.

FROM CARRICK-ON-SHANNON

Heading towards Leitrim you'll join the Shannon-Erne Canal - a 63km waterway that connects the two rivers of the same name. Explore along this canal up until Ballinamore, then retrace your journey. The winding Shannon leads you to Lough Key, in the middle of which sits a small island that's home to McDermott's Castle. Elsewhere in Boyle visit the 12th century Cistercian abbey. Heading south, don't miss Athlone which is the largest town on the banks of the Shannon and you can be sure that Irish life is in full swing!



FROM **BANAGHER**

If you are travelling towards Athlone then you will pass Clonmacnoise - famous among other things for its monastery ruins also known as «the seven churches». Well worth a visit if you're a history buff! In the opposite direction, visit the Renaissance castle of Portumna then continue to Lough Derg, a must-see lake which has many typical Irish pubs and restaurants dotted around it.

FROM **BELLANALECK**

If you are navigating from Bellanaleck, make sure you have British Pounds Sterling currency as this port is located in Northern Ireland! Explore the vastness of Lower Lough Erne and Upper Lough Erne. You will travel in a peaceful and idyllic setting, surrounded by hills and small islands, sometimes deserted. Don't miss the town of Enniskillen and its castle museum.


Set sail on the rural rivers of Hungary! Nicols have two departure bases to choose from - Kisköre in the south sailing between lakes and national parks or Tokaj in the north and in the heart of a world-famous wine region.

FROM **TOKAJ**

Tokaj is located on the banks of the Bodrog River and is known as a city of wines and festivals. There are many excellent restaurants and wineries which have been listed on the UNESCO World Heritage List including **the famous Tokaj wine** that Louis XIV described as "the wine of kings and the king of wines"!

You can cruise in three directions from the Nicols Tokaj base. Heading along the Bodrog River you can reach the town of Sátoraljaújhely on the border of Slovakia. While here visit **the large Zemplén Adventure Park**. On the return journey, spend a night moored close to **the castle of Sárospatak** and stop off at the village of Bodrogkeresztúr where you can go canoeing in the protected Bodrogzug-Tokaj Park. Throughout your journey you'll be surrounded by mountains and vineyards.

The other available itineraries from Tokaj are a cruise on the Upper Tisza to the north towards Tiszabercel and then to Dombrád, or in the other direction south through pretty countryside and cruising until the hydroelectric power station of Tiszalök before returning to Tokaj. You can also choose a one-way cruise to end at the Kisköre base.



FROM **KISKÖRE**

A cruise from Kisköre sees you switch between navigating on lakes and rivers – with stop offs at Abádszalók and Tiszafüred for **swimming**, **fishing** or dinner in the evening in a local restaurant to discover Hungarian cuisine. Sailing upstream on the Tisza River takes you to Tiszacsege, where the **famous fish restaurant** "Halászcsárda" awaits you. Continue your cruise to Tiszalök, where you'll find the impressive hydroelectric power station which can be visited. On the return journey, stop at Andrassy Castle in Tiszadob, then on to Lake Tisza and then to Poroszló and the 'Ecocentre' with its giant aquarium – the perfect family visitor attraction. Nature lovers should also explore the Hortobágy National Park where you'll also find the famous Hungarian "Puszta" (the largest grassland plain in Central Europe), a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
